Our club members Gavin, Kayleigh and Hannah have returned from representing Scotland at the 2013 IWAS World Games which were held in Stadskanaal, Holland.



The 3 athletes returned with an incredible haul of 13 medals and 6 World Records. Gavin won four Gold medals and set four new World Records in 100m, 200m, 400m and 800m. Kayleigh took Gold in 200m, 400m and 800m, with a new World Record time in the 800m, a silver in the 100m and a bronze in the club throw event. Hannah brought home Gold and a World Record in the 100m, Silver in 200m and 400m, and a Bronze in the 800m.
